What Post-Secondary Schools Need to Know About Village Green



- Chartered by the RI State Board of Regents as a state approved public school program in June of 2013.
- Blending Learning school with 180 day attendance requirement per state law; we strive for 60% online with 40% face-to-face teaching during the school day.
- Village Green Charter School is a “bricks and mortar” school which uses a virtualized curriculum.
- Proficiency/Mastery based program where 100% of the curriculum must be completed for course credit with a minimum of a 70% proficiency to move on from lesson to lesson or unit to unit.
- **VGCS** has a 100% Common Core Aligned curriculum using Edgenuity. The e-courseware curriculum is difficult and nationally normed.
- Rigorous & high level coursework which is delivered through an e-courseware platform but with tremendous teacher input and support.
- 1:12 teacher to student ratio; all teachers are RI State certified and are “Highly Qualified” in their subjects.
- 1.5:1 device to student ratio; Village Green uses a virtual desktop and thin client VMware system.
- 21st Century Skills are needed to succeed; self-paced coursework, self-motivation, teamwork and collaboration, self-advocacy, time management, life/work balance.
- Senior Capstone/Portfolio required to graduate per RI Board of Regents regulations.
